

Medical Preceptorship Information Sheet

(Please keep this information for future reference)

The medical preceptorship program (1 credit) pairs qualified students with a physician in Corvallis or the surrounding area for the duration of one academic term. Participants are required to shadow their preceptor for a minimum of 27 hours in order to satisfy course requirements. Preference is given to students that are graduating during the current academic year, or juniors that are planning to apply to medical school during the coming cycle.

Applicants must:

1. Have a minimum 3.25 overall GPA
2. Be enrolled at Oregon State University
3. Have completed sophomore level science coursework (General Chemistry, General Biology, Organic Chemistry)
4. Have Junior or Senior standing
5. Participate in a Group Interview
6. Have never previously participated in the preceptorship

The preceptorship is competitive and placement opportunities are limited. Therefore, not all students that apply will be guaranteed an interview, and not all students that are interviewed will be accepted into the program. If accepted, you are required to attend an orientation and comply with all requirements of the medical facility acting as your host.

To be considered, complete the following application before the due date (Friday of week two the term before you wish to participate). Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Completed applications should be returned to cody.duncan@oregonstate.edu no later than 7pm of the due date.

In addition to completing the application, you should be prepared to submit the following items in short order, once a physician match is made:

1. 10-panel drug screen test (to be arranged with medical facility)
2. Criminal Background check (to be arranged with medical facility)
3. Complete Immunization records, typically including hepatitis B, MMR, varicella, Tdap, COVID-19, & TB screening

During the program, you will be expected to

- Monitor your hours and ensure that you meet 27 hours at minimum. If you are in danger of not meeting this requirement, contact Cody Duncan as soon as possible.
- Complete 3 reflective journaling assignments. Failure to complete the assignments will lead to a no-pass grade
- Cover the cost of any costs incurred to participate in the program, including drug-screening, background check, and immunizations/screenings.
- Wear a nametag (provided) any time you are at the medical facility, and wear a lab coat if required.
