#### **BioHealth Sciences**

The BioHealth Sciences major is designed for students seeking a degree with an interdisciplinary background in the life sciences, physical sciences, social sciences and public health, this rigorous bachelor's program will deepen your understanding of human health, the origins of disease and the research for future cures. While the Corvallis campus coupled with an option contains most, if not all, of the prerequisites required by professional schools for admission, the online program is not intended for those who want to advance to a health-related professional school in fields such as dentistry, medicine, pharmacy or physical therapy. Specialized pre-professional school options within the program are not available to distance students because they require the completion of specific courses that are not currently offered online by Oregon State. The program's advisors will work with you to ensure that your courses will help prepare you for future success.



# Your Bachelor's Degree (BS) in the College of Science



- A minimum of 180 credits are required for graduation; 60 must be upper division (300 and 400-level courses).
- A maximum of 135 credits earned at a community college may be applied toward a bachelor's degree at OSU.
- Only courses with letter prefixes and numbers above 100 can be accepted.
- Some courses can count towards your major and the Baccalaureate Core. Check with your advisor.
- Options available. See "Important Notes".

## **Important Notes & Resources**

#### **Important Notes for the College and Major:**

- Grade requirements: Students need a C- or better in all lower division math, biology, and chemistry coursework.
- See a sample degree plan by searching "BioHealth Sciences" at <u>admissions.oregonstate.edu/find-your-major</u>
- Options are not required, and available to Corvallis campus students only. Interested students can select from: Pre-Clinical Laboratory Sciences, Pre-Dentistry, Pre-Medicine/Pre-Podiatry, Pre-Optometry, Pre-Pharmacy, Pre-Physical Therapy, or Pre-Physician Assistant.
- Other similar majors to explore: Biology, Biochemistry & Biophysics, Biochemistry & Molecular Biology, Microbiology, Zoology.
- Math, Chemistry and some Baccalaureate Core are priority courses to complete before transferring to OSU.
- For BioHealth Sciences students, the best time to transfer is fall term, particularly due to the required three term science series courses.
- It is important to speak with a College of Science Advisor early on, and often, to ensure correct course selection and sequencing.

#### Resources and OSU Information:

- Students do not have to complete a transfer degree in order to transfer to OSU.
  - o If you've completed the Oregon AAOT, all requirements of the Baccalaureate Core are complete except for Synthesis Courses and Writing Intensive Courses.
